The PLA has received a letter from Dalton Warner Davis advising of the application by Gateway Energy Centre Limited to vary consent 01.08.10.04/462/C granted on 4 August 2011 under S36 of the Electricity Act 1989 and the direction under section 90(2) of the Town and Country Planning Act to construct and operate a 900MW combined cycle gas turbine generating station. The application seeks consent to vary the permitted generation capacity of GEC from "about 900MW" to "up to 1250MW." It is noted that the underground gas pipeline and associated above ground installation and the high voltage electrical connection are not subject to any variation request.

The PLA has no objection to the proposal to increase the generation capacity and supports the proposed amendment to condition (15) which now requires an investigation into the use of the river for the transport of materials and plant associated with the construction and decommissioning of the development.
